



HEALTH SERVICES RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP FOR PHYSICIANS

OVERVIEW

The Denver/Seattle Center of Innovation (COIN) for Veteran-Centered and Value-Driven Care, located in Denver, Colorado is seeking enthusiastic and innovative applicants a Postdoctoral Fellowship in Health Services Research (HSR) for physicians.

The two-year HSR Fellowship Program provides research training to physician researchers who have interest areas that position them to improve Veterans health. The Fellowship works closely with AcademyHealth as a national coordinating center to provide high-quality training and curriculum focused on Learning Health Systems core competencies.

The HSR Fellowship emphasizes education, research, and mentorship. Physician Fellows devote 80% percent of their time to health service research, and/or education activities, and spend the remaining 20% providing clinical care. Physician Fellows may earn a MS/MPH degree from the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Completion of a residency program accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate medical Education (ACGME) or the Bureau of Professional Education (BPE) of the American Osteopathic Association.
- Not be enrolled simultaneously in any other accredited physician residency or Fellowship Program (waiver required for this)
- Be appropriately board certified or eligible.
- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Meets COVID Vaccine Requirements

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

- Stipend rate is based on the post-graduate (PG) level the fellow attained through previous ACGME accredited residency training and equivalent experiences.
- Fellows receive health insurance and vacation benefits.
- Technical support available during Fellowship.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Commitment to pursue health services research in rapidly changing health care settings
- Demonstrates interest in high-value care for Veterans in alignment with Denver COIN
- Potential to succeed in a career incorporating health services research for Veterans.
- Match with available mentors at Denver COIN/University of Colorado – Anschutz Medical Campus
